### **Project Title: ReCollection**

Jessica Ferrari and Memento Media are partnering with Moreland City Council to produce an oral history based documentary project entitled ReCollection.

### **About the project:**

ReCollection is about recording the history, places and faces of Moreland.

The oral history-based film project is part of the Coburg Carnivale which will be held on the 22nd and 23rd of September 2017. ReCollection will showcase local history exhibits and short documentaries while also providing the opportunity for some event attendees to add to the collection by having their stories filmed.

### **Why participate:**

Oral history provides a way for ordinary people to have their life experiences acknowledged and for everyone to contribute their experiences to the community and future generations. Personal stories provide a richer and more nuanced understanding of local history.

### **How to be involved:**

You can contribute to ReCollection by agreeing to participate in an oral history film interview. The interview may be used to compile short local history documentaries and/or short film 'bites' which will be made publically available. We may publish material online through various websites (for example Moreland City Council, WikiNorthia, Moreland Libraries, Memento Media, YouTube), on television, and through public screenings and film festivals.

Your participation in the ReCollection project includes agreeing to:

- participate in one filmed interview about your life experience (5-20 minutes)
- provide relevant photographs where possible
- the recorded material to be submitted Memento Media
- the recorded material being used by Moreland City Council and Memento Media for educational and/or promotional purposes.

As the purpose of the project is to collect and share Moreland's memories, we will require all interview participants to sign a consent and release form. Please refer to the detailed Consent and Release Form that will be provided for you to sign at the time of the interview.
